Interfraternity Council Community Service Policy

We, the members of the Interfraternity Council, are dedicated to self improvement, giving back to our campus and the local community, as well as supporting national and international charitable organizations. Therefore, community service is an essential component of Greek Life. Each individual house in the Interfraternity Council must meet the following community service requirements each quarter. Failure to follow the community service policy shall result in a fine as stated in the IFC Fine Policy.

Each fraternity must participate in events in which members volunteer as a group. Due to size and time constraints, fraternities may choose from the following options to complete their quarterly service requirement:

- 1) Two events with at least 25 members present or 50% of the Chapter total
- 2) Three events with at least 15 members present or 40% of the Chapter total
- 3) Four events with at least 10 members present or 30% of the Chapter total
- 4) Five events with at least 5 members present or 20% of the Chapter total

The fraternity may combine these service options as follows:

- One 25 person or 50% of the Chapter total event= Two 15 person or 40% of the Chapter total events= Three 10 person or 30% of the Chapter total events= Four 5 person or 20% of the Chapter total events
- One 15 person or 40% of the Chapter total event= Two 10 person or 30% of the Chapter total events= Three 5 person or 20% of the Chapter total events
- One 10 person or 30% of the Chapter total event= Two 5 person or 20% of the Chapter total events

For example, the fraternity may choose to complete their service requirement as:

- One 25 person or 50% of the Chapter total event and
 - Two 15 person or 40% of the Chapter total events or,
 - Three 10 person or 30% of the Chapter total events or,
 - Four 5 person or 20% of the Chapter total events
- Two 15 person events or 40% of the Chapter total and
 - Two 10 person events or 30% of the Chapter total or,
 - Three 5 person events or 20% of the Chapter total
- Three 10 person or 30% of the Chapter total events and two 5 person or 20% of the Chapter total events

For each group community service event, the fraternity must submit a completed service report to the IFC Director of Community Service. This document must include the date, location, organization, time, number of brothers present, description of the event/duties, and either a signature from an event supervisor, or a picture of your group

at the event. All compliance shall be at the discretion of the IFC Director of Community Service.

All members participating in community service events, as well as philanthropy events, shall be sober for the event.
