



IFC Recruitment Policy Rules and Potential New Member Expectations

- I. Each potential new member must have and maintain a minimum G.P.A. of 2.0 to be considered by any fraternity. Some fraternities will have higher academic standards for membership.
- II. Each potential new member has the right to attend as many open recruitment events from as many fraternities as he wishes.
 - a. Fraternities may not require attendance at any designated number of events in order to receive a bid
- III. Fraternities may not have alcohol available or served at any recruitment event regardless of the age of the persons in attendance. Such actions will result in dismissal of the new member from the IFC recruitment process and judicial actions against the fraternity.
- IV. Each potential new member may receive a bid from more than one fraternity.
- V. Fraternities may only give a bid to a potential new member on the designated Bid Day, after 6:00 pm.
 - a. Potential New Members may only be invited to an event on Bid Day after 8 am on that day.
- VI. The Day of Silence after designated Bid Day applies to all IFC fraternities
 - a. Potential New Members have the option of waiting 24 hours before accepting a bid extended from a fraternity.
 - b. Fraternities are not allowed to communicate with Potential New Members during Day of Silence.
- VII. The following calendar, copies of which will be provided by IFC, shall be placed on the back of every Fraternity Rush Schedule and included on any Facebook event so that every potential new member may read and understand it:

1st Week:

Monday or Tuesday: IFC Kickoff BBQ

Wednesday – Saturday: Individual Fraternity Rush Events

2nd Week:

Sunday – Monday: Fraternities vote on who to offer bids to

Tuesday: BID DAY. Beginning at 8am, fraternities will begin calling those whom they are offering a bid to.

Wednesday: Day of Silence – Fraternities cannot contact students who have received a bid and not accepted.

Thursday: Deadline to accept bid. Pinning will take place within the following days dependent on the Fraternity.

Thursday – Saturday: Optional secondary rush begins. Potential new members may receive a bid at any time from participating Fraternities.

3rd Week:

Sunday – Monday: Fraternities vote on who to offer bids to in secondary rush. Pinning will follow afterwards dependent on the individual Fraternity.
