 - 4.4.1.1.1. Coordinators \$70,000 thousand each.
 - 4.4.1.1.2. Operating Expenses: \$25,000
 - 4.4.1.1.3. Total: \$165,000
 - 4.4.1.2. Income from Fee - "Cost Recovery"
 - 4.4.1.2.1. Year 1- \$80,000 (\$10 per member)
 - 4.4.1.2.2. Year 2- \$120,000 (\$15 per member)
 - 4.4.1.2.3. Year 3- \$160,000 (\$20 per member)
 - 4.4.1.3. If there is any money left over after total expenses are used from the Cost Recovery Effort, it will be redistributed back to Greek Life
