Suspensions and Probations

Under Investigation

A chapter may be placed under investigation if the Dean of Students Office has reason to believe that the chapter has directly violated or may be connected with a violation of university policy. If a judicial hearing is initiated by Dean of Students office, the chapter will remain Under Investigation status until the hearing has concluded.

Probation

A chapter on probation will not be allowed to conduct any social activities within the chapter or with any other student organization on campus (ISO's included). The chapter may conduct any other activity that is not defined as social (i.e. brotherhood/ sisterhood, community service, philanthropy, meetings, alumni events, etc.) Alcohol will **not** be allowed at non-social events or activities. Special circumstances may be granted by the Fraternity & Sorority Life Office on a case by case basis.

Suspension

A chapter on suspension will have a suspended recognition with the university. All activities must be approved by the Dean of Students office and the chapter's headquarters (if applicable). Activities that will need approval include but are not limited to social activities, philanthropy, community service, meetings, alumni events, campus involvement, fundraisers, etc. Special circumstances may be granted by the Fraternity & Sorority Life office on a case by case basis.

Disaffiliation

A chapter that has been disaffiliated will no longer be recognized as a student organization of California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo. The Dean of Students office will be required to give the organization a date in which the organization will be allowed to petition for their return to campus.
