## Expectations of Chapter Leadership & Accountability Measures

The following information is provided to assist Chapters in understanding and fulfilling all requirements to remain in good standing with the Fraternity & Sorority Life office. Please review all information carefully to ensure you, as a leader in your chapter, are able to fulfill requirements and submit materials by desired due dates and your chapter remains in good standing.

### OVERVIEW:

- All chapters and colonies affiliated with the Interfraternity Council (IFC), Panhellenic Association (PHA), or United Sorority & Fraternity Council (USFC) are **required** to complete and/or submit all requested materials to the Fraternity & Sorority Life office by the due date assigned.
- Any missed deadlines, missed meetings or incomplete submissions can result in sanctions placed on the chapter by the Fraternity & Sorority Life office.
- The possible sanctions and accountability measures are listed below.
