

Philanthropy Date Selection Process

Community Service and Philanthropy are large parts of Fraternity & Sorority life (FSL), and because of this, the Fraternity & Sorority Life office will begin organizing the process of philanthropy date selection to prevent overlap of events, over-programming in the community, increase attendance at each chapters event and provide incentives related to academic achievement.

Chapter presidents will meet with FSL Staff each quarter to schedule philanthropy events as a community. The date selection process will be based on overall chapter grade point average from the previous quarter. Chapter Presidents will attend a scheduled meeting, where each president will come prepared with multiple date options for their philanthropy event for the upcoming quarter. Based on GPA, the chapter with the highest GPA will select their philanthropy date first. The order of chapter selection will continue by GPA.

Winter 18 Process to schedule for Spring 18

Philanthropy event dates for Spring 18 Quarter will be selected via an online form based on chapter GPA from the Fall 17 quarter.

Spring 18 Process to schedule for Fall 18

Philanthropy event dates for the Fall 18 Quarter will be selected at the ALL PRESIDENTS meeting on April 16, 2018 at 6:00 PM, based on the chapter GPA from the Winter 18 quarter.

Fall Process 18 Process to schedule for Winter 19

Philanthropy event dates for the Winter 19 Quarter will be selected at the ALL PRESIDENTS RETREAT in September 2018 (date, time and location TBD), based on the chapter GPA from the Spring 18 quarter.
